Privacy Notice

How we will use your data:

"AstraZeneca", "We", "Us" and "Our" refers to AstraZeneca Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 54 009 682 311. 66 Talavera Road, Macquarie Park, NSW 2113), a company that belongs to the AstraZeneca group companies (www.astrazeneca.com). AstraZeneca will collect and use the personal data that you provide when you register to attend, and participate in, a virtual meeting through one of our services providers (for example Webstream Communications, Zoom, MS Teams, however this not limited and may change from time to time). We use this information to verify your identity, to ensure that the event is attended only by healthcare professionals, to assist your virtual participation and to administer the event, better understand the profiles of participants in our events and provide data to aggregate attendee statistics. In addition to the above, AstraZeneca may also process your personal data for the following purposes:

Video and audio will be held for up to one year, and other registration page info will be stored for 1 year. If you disagree with the recording options, you will be provided with an option to not join the meeting.
- We may apply some basic profiling on your personal information in order to better program our virtual interactions
 with health care professionals and to engage with professionals that AstraZeneca may wish to collaborate with.

What personal information will be collected:

We may process the following personal information or categories of data through the registration page and by using video and audio recording: Name, Location – Country, Email Address, Specialty, Hospital Affiliation, Clinic Affiliation, License Number/National ID, Nationality, photo &/or video image, voice and information you wish to share with us regarding your opinions. We would prefer that you do not mention any obvious identifying details about yourself that are not needed or relevant in relation to the purpose of the recordings (such as your personal address).
